SAIC Summer Internship Pilot Programme 2023 – Terms and Conditions

- **Participants must be eligible to work in the UK.**
- This is a pilot programme which will last between 10 weeks over the summer and is aimed at university undergraduate and college students who are either nearly graduating or have recently graduated and are seeking to gain work experience as an intern.
- It is intended to provide interns with an opportunity to experience working in the aquaculture sector and supply chain via **any/all job families**. The intern will be employed within a participating organisation (PO), which could be either an academic institution or a private company. The intern will be an employee of the PO for the duration of the programme, complying with their orientation, on-boarding and health and safety procedures. The PO will then invoice SAIC for the costs incurred to employ the intern for up to £425 per week for the 10-week term.
- SAIC will lead the recruitment and sifting process and can conduct interviews with candidates alongside the PO. Successful candidates will then be employed by the participating organisation and can invoice SAIC as indicated above.
